All students in sixth, seventh, and eighth completed the second nine weeks benchmark on 1-12-2017.

Sixth grade students are starting a unit on Latin American locations and culture.

Eighth grade students have started a unit focusing on the economic, political, and social changes that occurred during the New South period of 1877 to 1918. They are completing protest posters related to the social divides during this time.

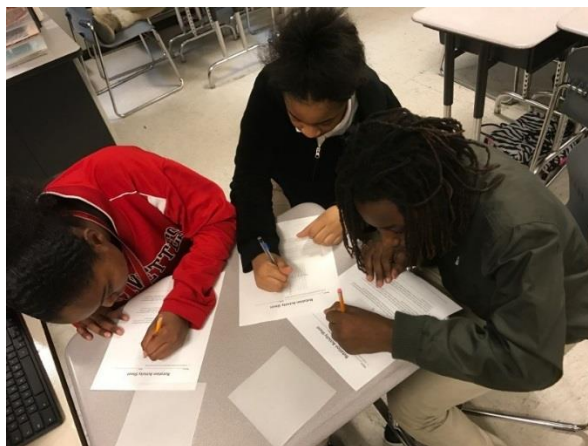
SCIENCE NEWS

GCSU Hands-on Science Tour

The Oak Hill 8th Grade SAGE (Steam Academy for Growth and Exploration) is departing for a series of GCSU seminars in science and engineering. The field trip will be hosted by the GCSU Academic Outreach program, and coordinated by Ruth Eilers with several GCSU students participating. The partnership between GCSU and the Oak Hill STEAM program has proved invaluable for all involved.

Students will learn about electrical functions, energy and renewable resources, as well as properties and element studies. The field trip GCSU is an excellent chance for Oak Hill students to explore new ideas with others, igniting our students' curiosity for science with a day of exploration and discovery. Hands-on exhibits and programs will engage students with many lasting benefits, while also sparking lifelong interest in science, math, engineering and technology.

Eighth grades are transforming in Math!

To introduce geometric transformations, students are discovering the rules for rotations in the coordinate plane using patty paper activities. In small groups students were using patty paper to show the effects of specific transformations. They discussed their findings with their group and had to develop a rule that would work with any set of points.
